RECREATION CENTER MEMBERSHIPS AND OTHER FACILITY INFORMATION

Membership to the facility is available to those who pay Blue Ash taxes. Full-Time employees working in Blue Ash or residents of Blue Ash may apply for a membership to the Recreation Center. Please see our Welcome Desk for more information. All areas of the Recreation Center are for Members Only with the exception of the designated areas, days and times of the Senior Programs. The café is open to the public but will not be available for game play during operating hours (Monday-Friday, 11am-2pm). These tables are limited in quantities and are needed for our customers who are purchasing meals from our café. All other programs that are listed in our Activity Guide are open to the public, however, registration and activity fees are required to participate. Please see our most current Activity Guide for information on these classes.

BRIDGE, DUPLICATE BRIDGE & OPEN CARDS/GAME PLAYERS

The area that is dedicated to all card and board game groups is in the Lower Level of the Recreation Center.
